#### **EDUCATION:**

Minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent plus relevant short-term courses. Graduate of a journeyman lineman apprenticeship program preferred.

Minimum of five years' experience in electric line construction, maintenance, and repair as a journeyman lineman, with demonstrated ability to supervise personnel. Foreman experience is preferred, as well as experience in a rural electric distribution system.

Must be able to supervise underground or overhead line crew and to promote adherence to all established safety rules, regulations and practices.

Must be capable of developing procedures and practices for switching, energizing, taking outages, and of issuing instructions to energize or de-energize lines.
